Treasurer's report: a question was raised about the offerings being low. More information will be available when the 2016 year-end reports are completed. Gail Keck made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by Adam Smith. Motion approved.

More time should be given to looking at all aspects of opening our church to this group, as the possibility of conflicts with other events happening.

Audit of the Church Financial Books: after discussion, the council determined for the years 2015 and 2016 an internal audit will be done. Arrangements will be made to do an external audit for the year 2017. Motion made by Cheri Comstock, seconded by Gail Keck. Motion approved.

Active Emergency Plan Team: members of this new team have been researching the best plans to have in place for our church in case of an emergency (i.e.: fire, tornado, active shooter). Other local churches have been contacted to see what plans they have in place. The team will continue to work on this and report back to the council at a future date. Team members are: Tom & Cindy Weikart, T.J. Weikart and Adam Smith.

Property: Hubbard Roofing has been paid in full for the work completed on the Education Roof. An estimate has been received in the amount of \$19,457 to replace the roof over Rice Hall. As part of the NLCF/FLC Letter of Understanding Addendum this amount will be paid out of 175th Anniversary monies.

The "Castle Roof" (the flat roof over upper narthex area) has been temporarily repaired after leaks were found in the upper narthex ceiling and the hallway upstairs. The cost was \$250 to complete these repairs. We have received an estimate of \$7,920 to replace this roof (with possible overages as the project is completed). Chris McKenrick made a motion, seconded by Cheri Comstock, to use Property Improvement monies to pay for this project. Motion approved. Since this amount is above the \$5,000 limit that council can approve without congregation approval, a special congregation meeting will take place on Sunday, April 23, 2017 after the worship service in the sanctuary.

An estimate of \$700 from JT Tree Service, Rushsylvania, OH, to remove a dead tree in the church's parking lot was received and approved by Property Team Members. Council agreed with this recommendation.

Work continues in Rice Hall to remove the old paneling in the stage area. This area will receive work on the drywall and paint to match the main Rice Hall area.

Stewardship: no report

Worship: written report. They continue to plan for the upcoming worship services.

The Standing Ministry Team reports were approved on a motion made by Gail Keck, seconded by Chris McKenrick. Motion approved.
