Treasurer Report: Council reviewed finalized treasurer reports from July and August 2017. Questions from council on why the front page of the finalized reports are copied with a post it note covering a portion of the report. It was shared that the second page is a copy of the first page without a post it note blocking the report. This cleared up the concern about the report. Budget is \$10,000 above based on an end of the year donation. Julie Zoldak made a motion to accept the treasurer report and Adam Smith seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Motion to accept the agenda: Julie Zoldak made a motion to adopt the agenda. Seconded by Corey VanHoose. Motion passed.

Adoption of October 2017 Minutes. Motion to adopt by Chris McKenrick and seconded by Corey VanHoose. Motion passed.

Congregation member's questions and comments: Rachel Gillespie brought a concern to council regarding the current cleaning service with which the church contracts. Rachel was concerned that there is not a detailed job description for Gill Cleaning Service and that he is not meeting the expectations of the congregation. She recommended putting job requirements in writing.

October attendance: 102

Emergency Safety Team: FLIRT (First Lutheran Incident Response Team) is finalizing the directions for how to respond in emergencies. Radios have been purchased to communicate in emergencies. Next meeting will be Nov. 15 at 9AM. Discussion of usher training. There will be cameras in the sanctuary and other key locations in and around the church. The FLIRT team will wear red name tags when in the church to members will know who to go to for assistance.

Dodge and Cox Funds: Part of this fund belongs to CHEF and a discussion needs to take place to find out where it came from and how to use these monies. Should this money be moved to Dodds for management or can it be released for use by Christian education.

Personnel meeting: Sexton. The importance of a good job description was agreed upon and is in the works. Personnel is looking at separate positions of cleaning and Sexton or combining

the two positions. The main factor is what the church can afford. Question on if the current cleaning service can keep up with the church renovations. Need duties in writing and this is being worked on. Felt that 30 hours per week for Sexton and cleaning would be enough. The position will not be able to be open until 2018.

175th project Updates: The portico is almost done and is looking very nice. Parking lot estimate is needed. Quality Paving is an option.

Portico, South wall repairs and increase in insurance rates for Pastor Larry Novak were voted on by email outside of council. All three issues were passed unanimously.

The agenda was approved on a motion made by Carl Gillespie, seconded by Chris McKenrick. Motion passed.

The minutes of the March 11, 2017, May 13, 2017 and September 9, 2017 meetings were presented and approved on a motion made by Loren Kipker, seconded by Carl Gillespie. Motion passed.

Church Parking Lot:

We have received 3 estimates for repaving of the church and LCS parking lots, and were reviewed. After a lengthy discussion, the team has decided to recommend to the 175th Anniversary Team to have Quality Paving, Belle Center, OH be awarded the contract. Motion made by Carl Gillespie, seconded by Dick Griffith. Motion passed. We look forward to being on their 2018 work schedule.

Property Team will be recommending to the 175th Team, to be included in this paving project, paving of the gravel parking area located west of the existing parking lot. The Property Team is looking at future use of this area and the need for more parking spaces.

The Portico work has been completed. Double D Construction, West Mansfield, did a great job on this project. We will be receiving a final invoice which will be paid out of the 175th Anniversary Funds, as this was the next project on the list to be completed. The brightness of the lights illuminates the parking lot at night and will help anyone that comes to the church for evening meetings or choir practice.

The missing and water damaged ceiling tiles in Rice Hall are being replaced. This work will continue as time allows.

Termite and water damage was found in the stairwell leading from the Detroit Street doors to the Youth Room needs to be addressed. Property Team brought this issue to Church Council and shared that it will be a 3- step process to repair.

Double D Construction was asked to give an estimate on doing the repairs. Council has accepted their bid for Step 1 of the project. They will begin this work as weather permits. This will require digging a section away from the outside of the church building and applying water repellant and stone for water drainage. Step 2 will then begin on the inside. Repair to the crumbling plaster wall. The final step will be to rebuild the staircase. At this point they cannot say how much of the staircase will need to be rebuilt.

The Kitchen Team continues to oversee the remodeling. New flooring has been installed and it looks nice. Cabinets, countertop, sink and new appliances will also be coming soon. As families get together for holiday gatherings, and ask to use the kitchen, we will try to make it as usable as possible.

Heating Issues:

The sanctuary area will need to have some heating equipment replaced. Griffith Plumbing will be looking into this issue. Work continues in the Confirmation Room and upstairs Adult Sunday school classroom heating issues.

The women's restroom in the lower hallway has had a new motion sensor switch installed. The hope is this will lower electricity costs as we have found this light to be left on overnight following group meetings. A second motion sensor will be installed in the men's restroom soon.

Property Team will be overseeing the construction of the Stewards of the Grounds Building, following the generous donation for this from a church family. Updates on this work will be included in future meeting minutes.

Leakage in the courtyard from the roof/ceiling will need to be addressed. We are attempting to contact Hubbard Roofing, Piqua, OH and Best Door & Window to see what options are available for repair or replacement.

Hubbard Roofing will also be looking into possible leakage in the upstairs large classroom. Plaster damage from the ceiling has been discovered. We need to determine if this is from a leak in the newly replaced roof over this area.

A motion to adjourn was made by Chris McKenrick, seconded by Carl Gillespie. Motion passed.
